DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, right side perspective view of a personal computer or similar article showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top, rear, left side perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear, elevational view thereof;

FIGS. 5 and 6 are respectively right and left side elevational views thereof;

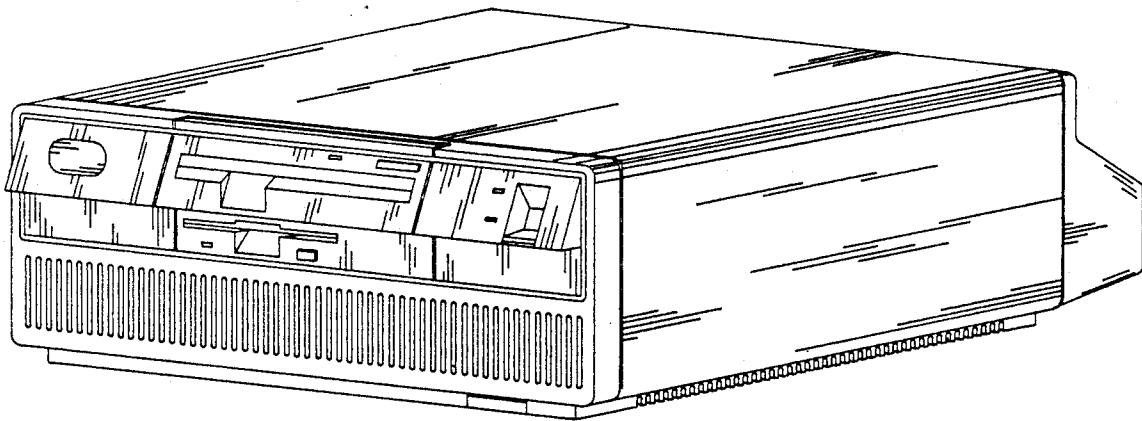
FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof;

The undisclosed views of the second embodiment are the same in appearance as those of the first embodiment.



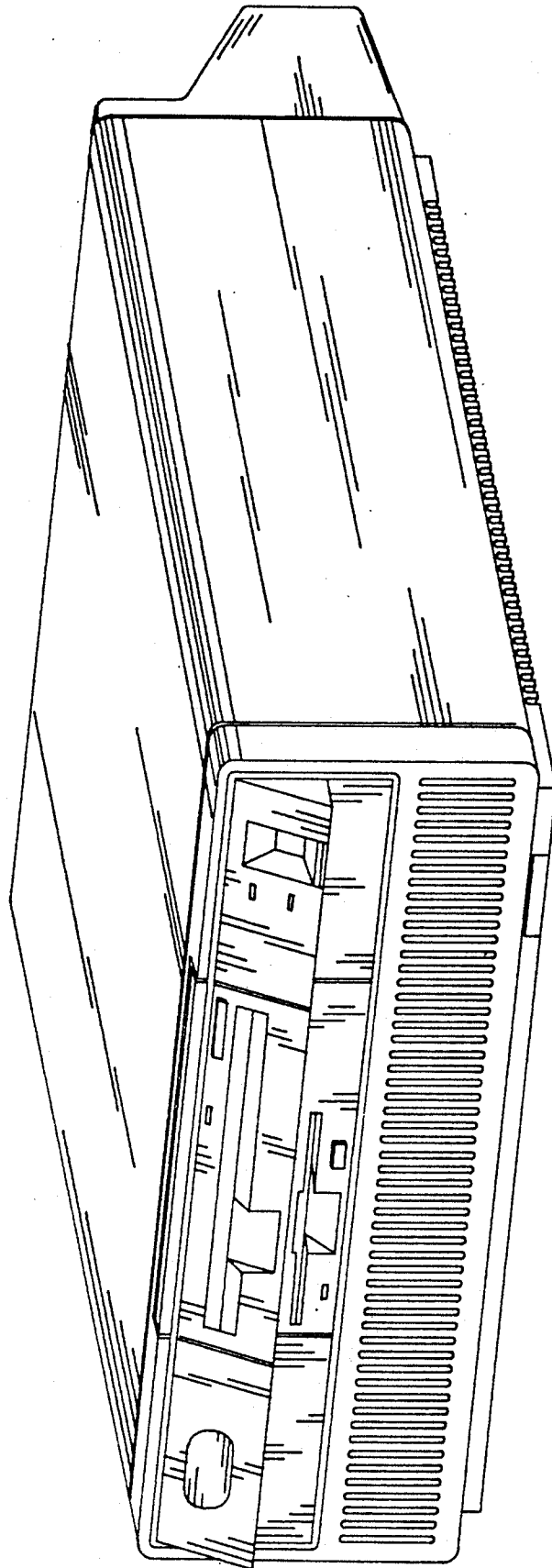

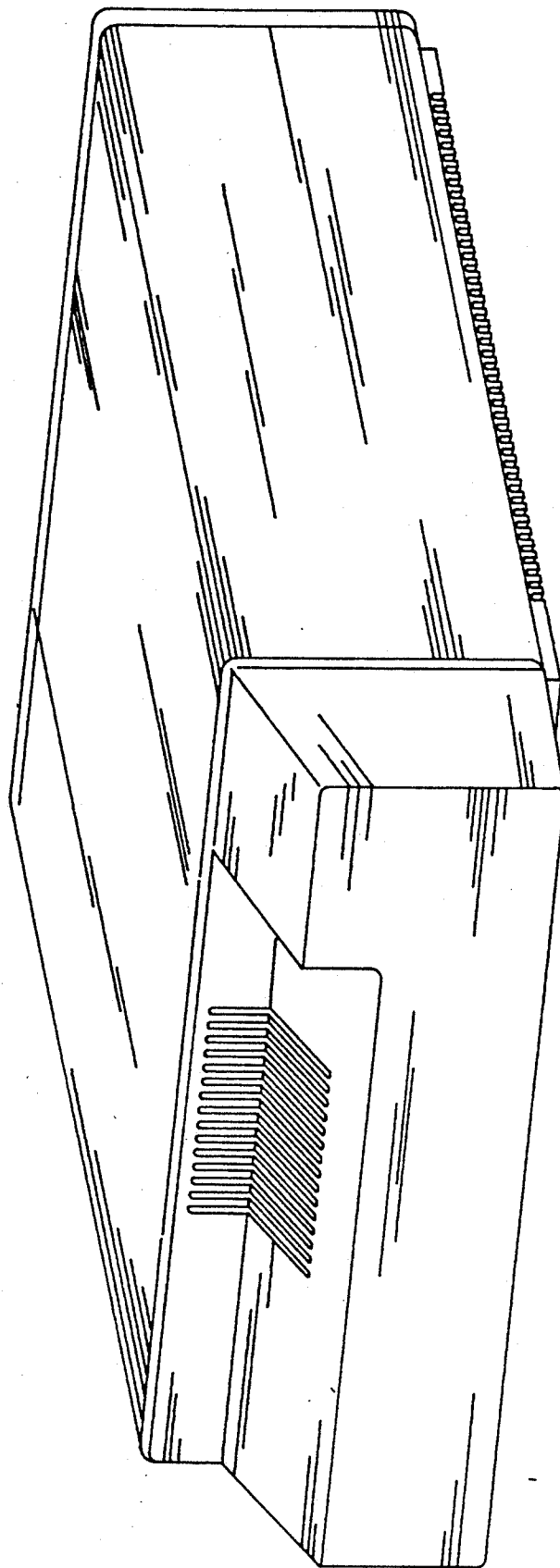

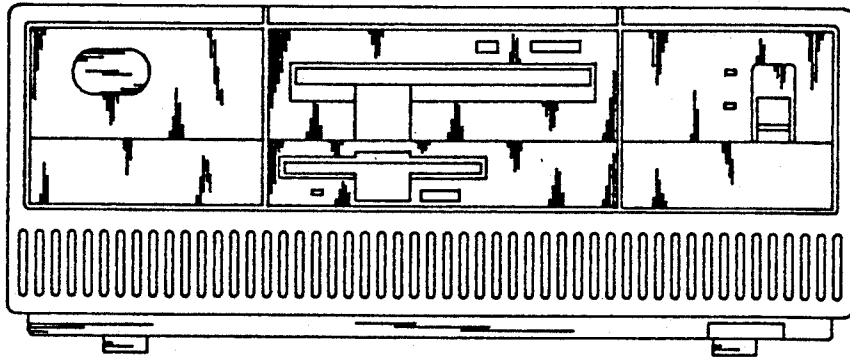

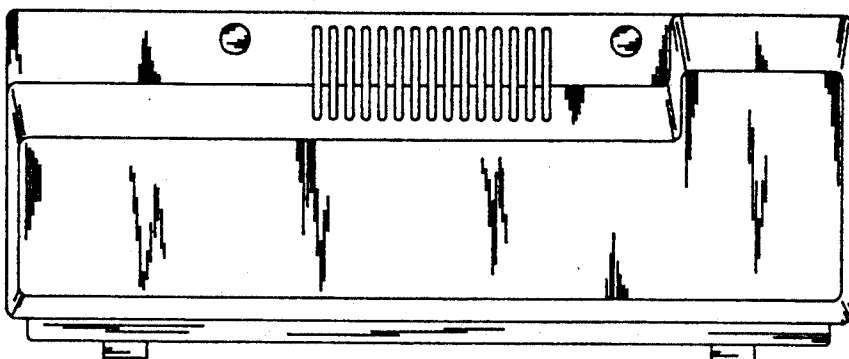

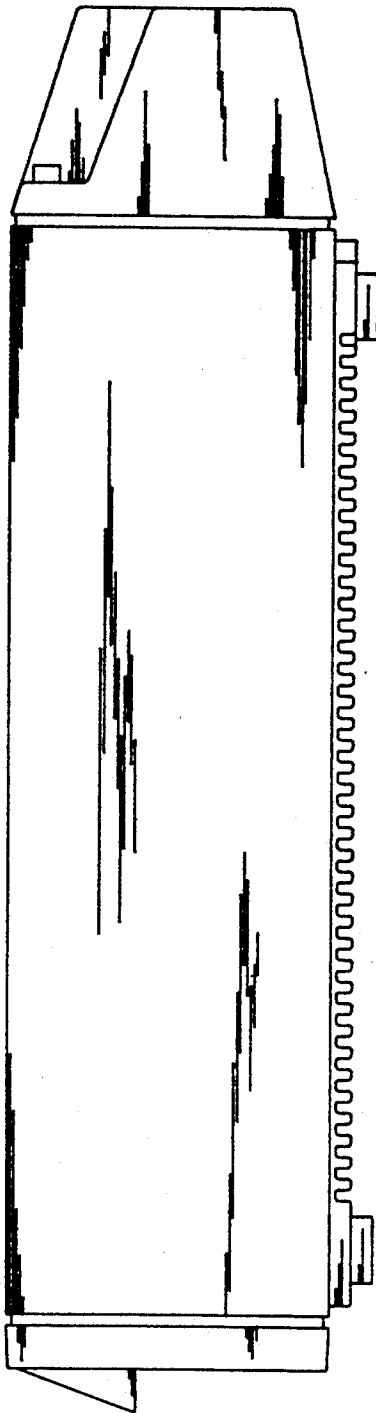

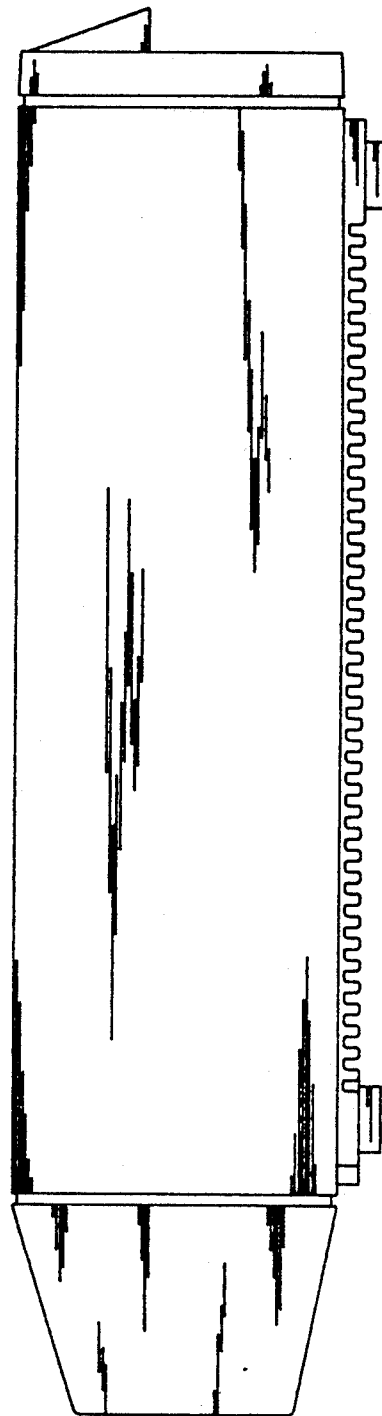

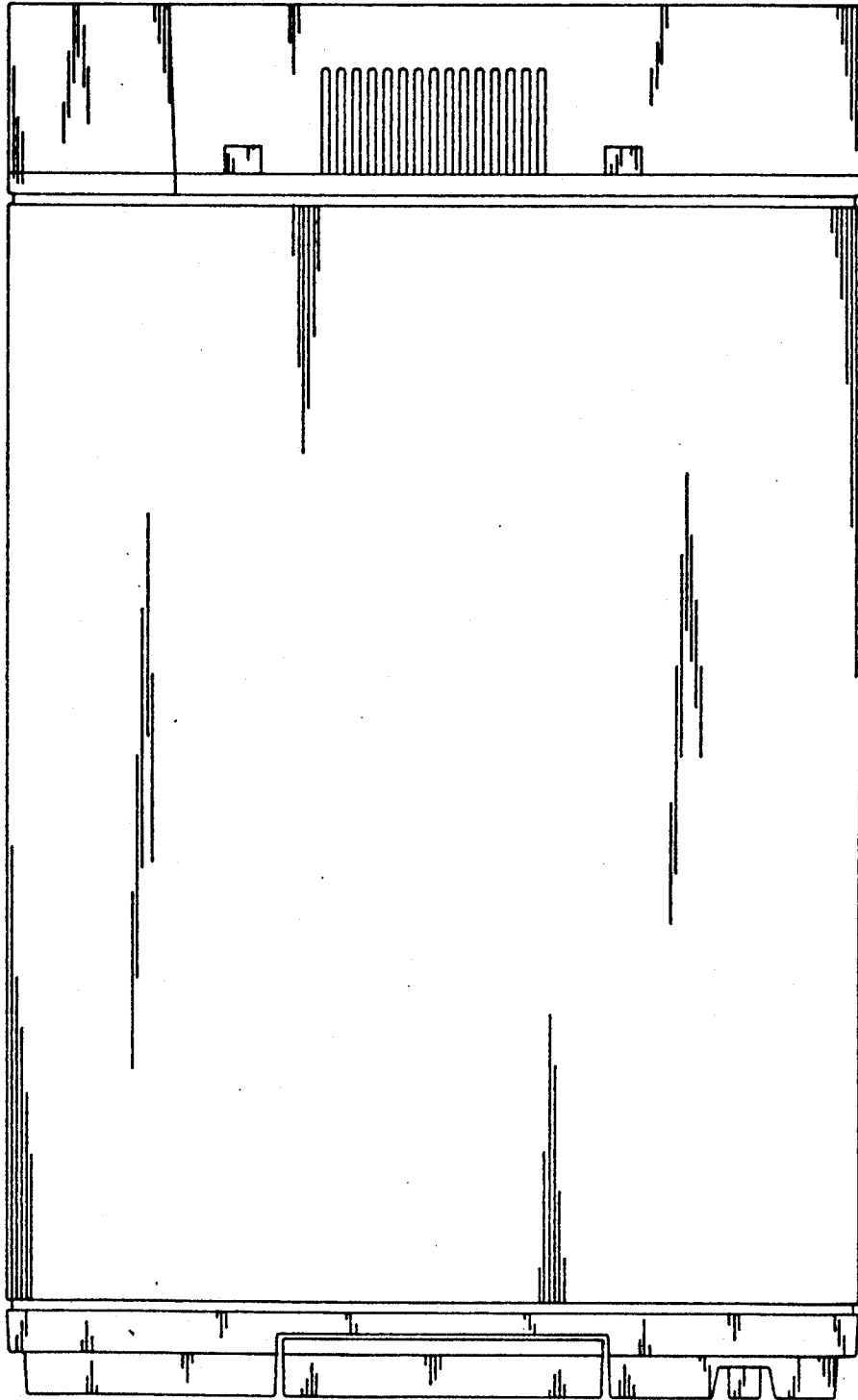
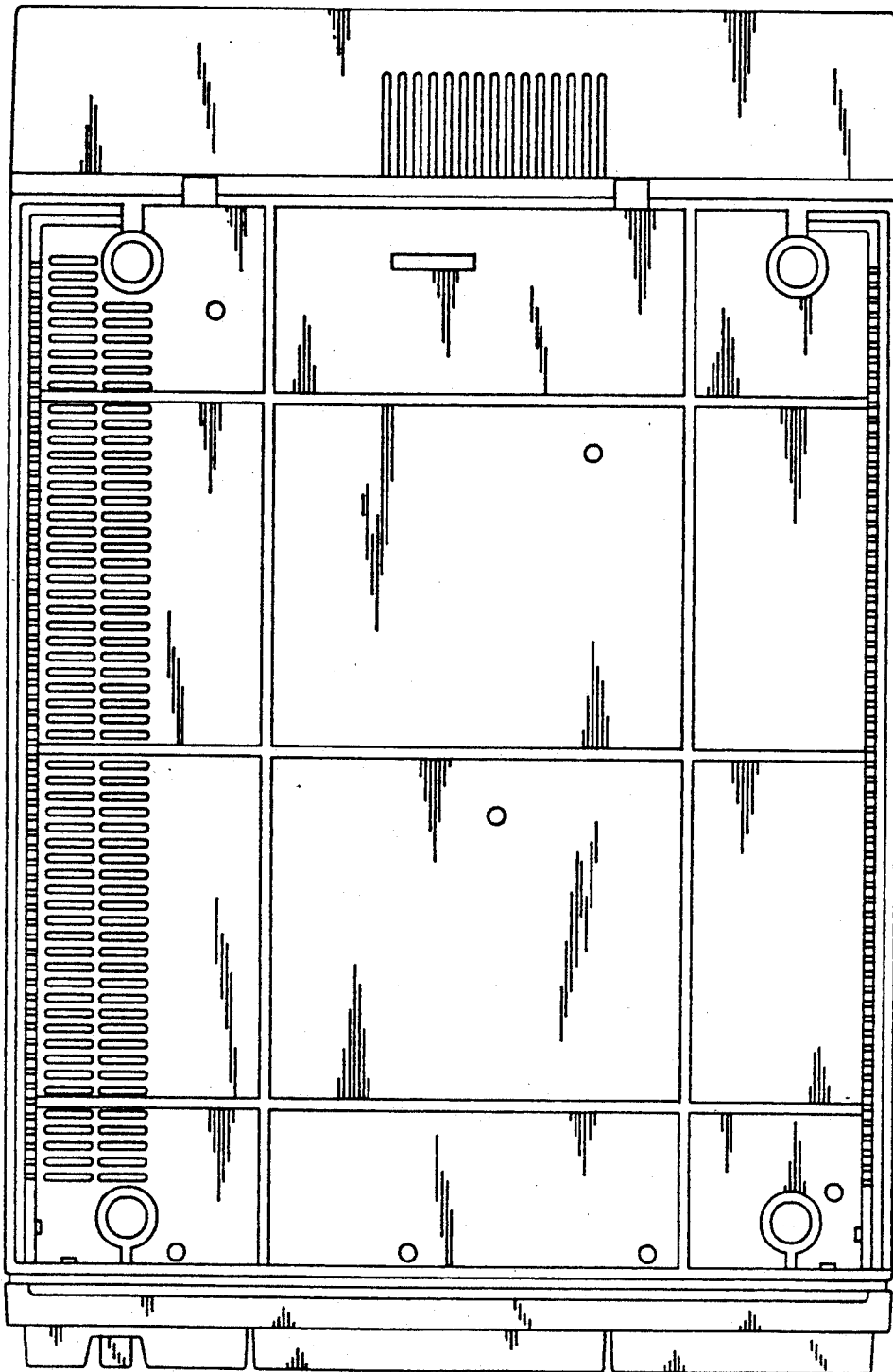

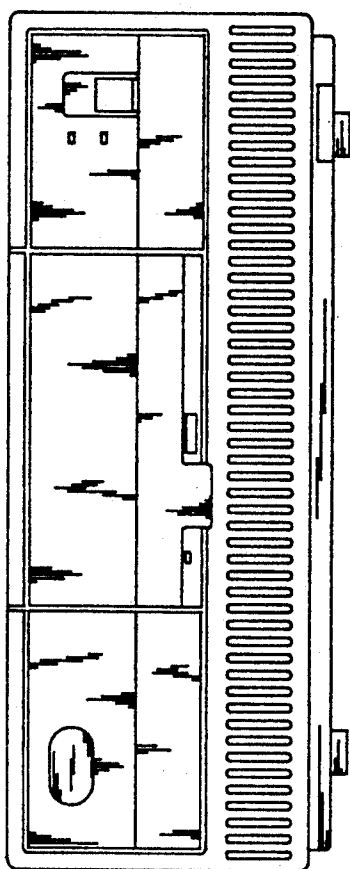

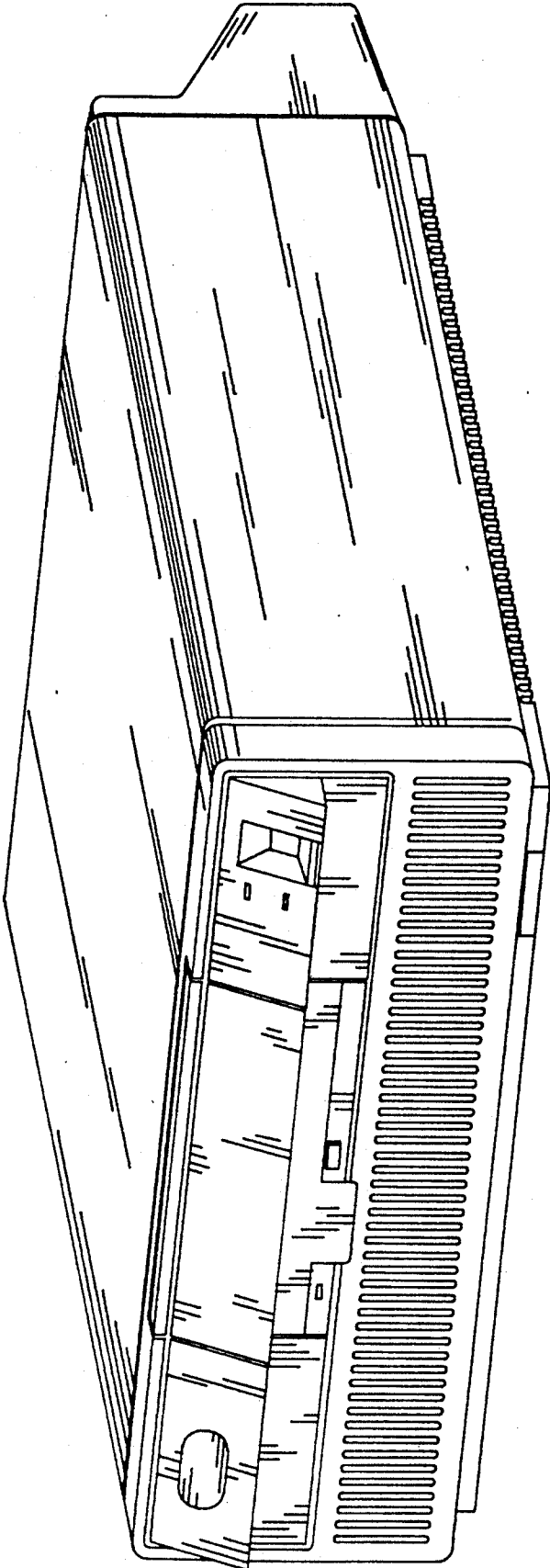
